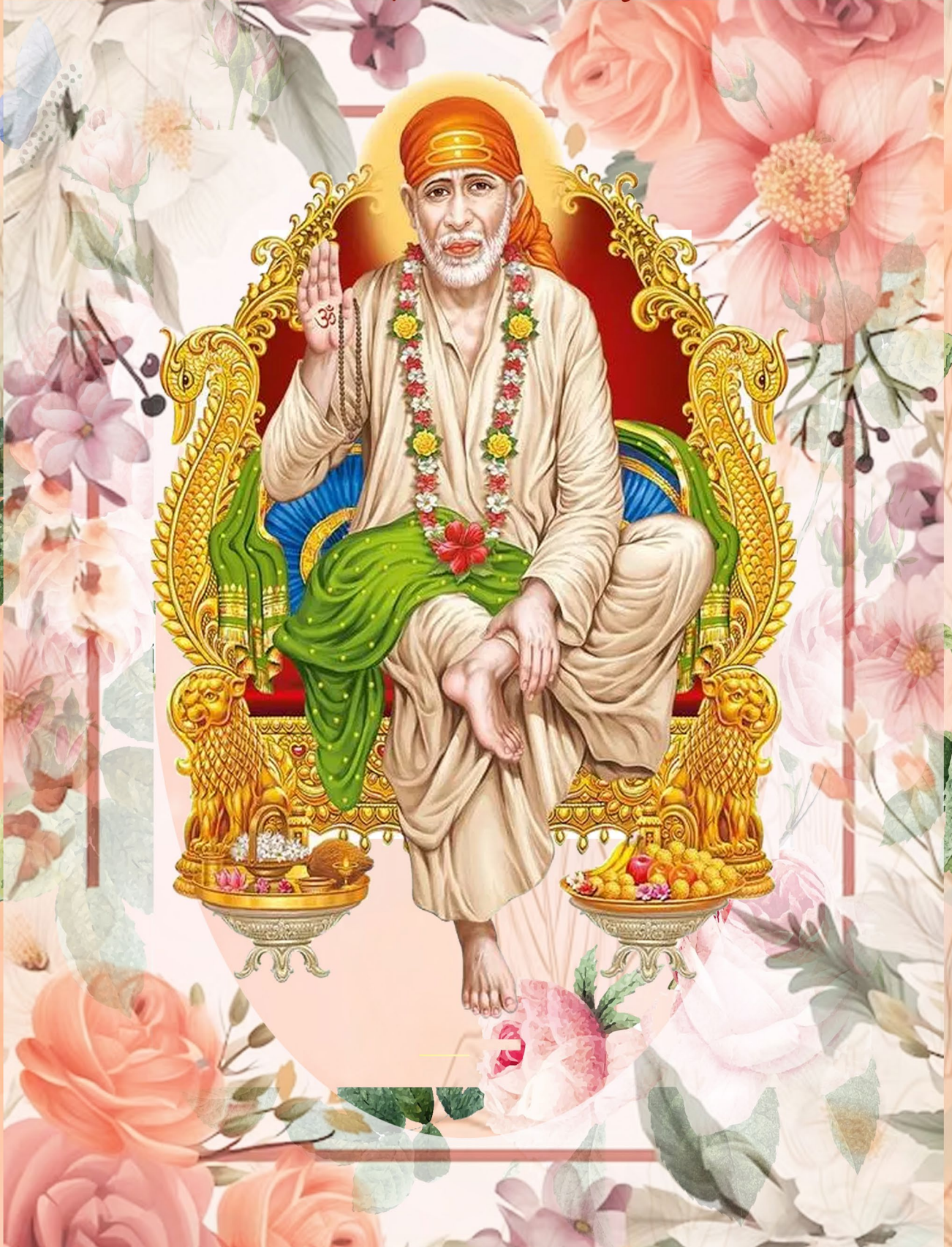

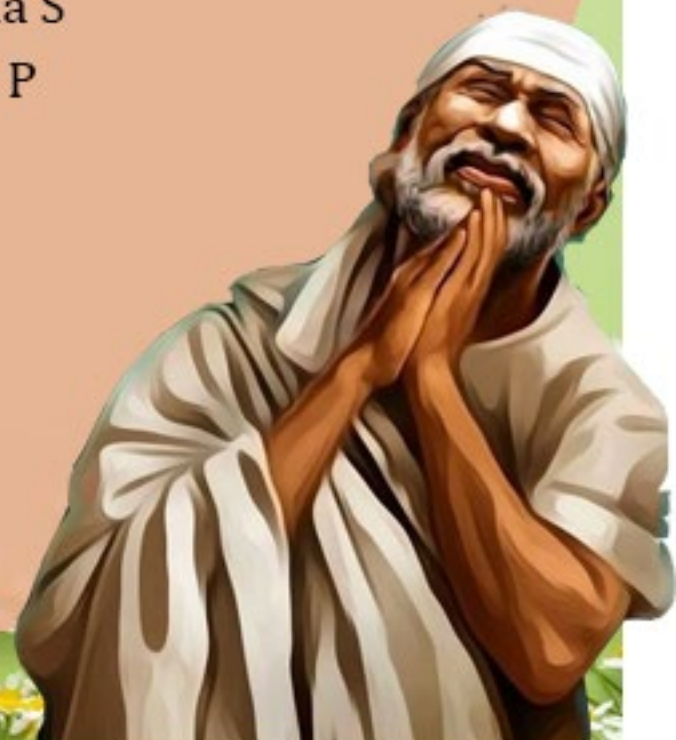

## *Baba Saved My Life*



It was in the year 1998 that I was caught in a legal tangle which was catastrophic, and if unresolved, it would have landed me up in jail. It so happened that a student of the department where I was teaching committed suicide and, in his suicide-note my name figured in. I was just 26 years old. It was a mystery whether he was killed or he committed suicide? I do not wish to get into those details.

The local newspapers were doing the rounds highlighting my 'not being local' status that would have added fuel to the fire. I was constantly praying to Baba to do justice as I was not involved in anyway. I was more than surprised that all the students came out in my favour, some of them sobbing, and showing utmost concern for my safety and well-being. This made the Vice-chancellor of the University to reach out to me; he even found a good lawyer to plead my case in the court. The lawyer was very honest but I was very skeptical about the concerned Judge, who was likely to be influenced by the local factors as I was told; thus, I was in constant agony thinking of my future.

The case went on for another two years and people said that it will linger for several years and will not resolve so easily. I was constantly worried as I was unmarried and staying alone on my own. I wanted to go abroad under certain fellowship but was not sure due the ongoing case at that time. I used to pray to Baba and sometimes also observed fast on Thursdays. As Baba's mercy befell, the previous Judge in whose jurisdiction my case was dealt got transferred and was replaced by a very honest and famous Judge who had a track record of clearing pending cases in a short time. Within no time, my case came for hearing. I was very disturbed those days notwithstanding support from my University fraternity and the then Vice Chancellor.

The trial was torture as I was made to sit on the accused chair for the case being in the nature of a criminal offence. After a couple of months, when the trial procedure was coming to an end my stress and sufferings were unimaginably heightening even though my conscience was clear. The day of judgement "coincidentally" fell on Thursday. I was waiting since morning and it became 6 p.m. and other judgements were coming one by one. When it was 6 p.m., the Judge stood up from his chair and wined up the proceedings, and

people started moving; the court time was almost over. My lawyers and some of my friends were disappointed and thought that the judge will give another date for passing judgement in my case.

By blessings and grace of Baba, however, the judge immediately came back, and the people who had started moving began to return and occupied their respective seats. It was very dramatic and spectacularly miraculous moment. The Judge suddenly located me in the crowd, and looked at me saying- “jaa tula sorun dilo” (in Marathi)- “well, I have acquitted you”. The judgment was not even typed as is the practice in the courts. He uttered these words and moved, and the court was over. This was a unique judgment happening within seconds. The written judgement was prepared probably later.

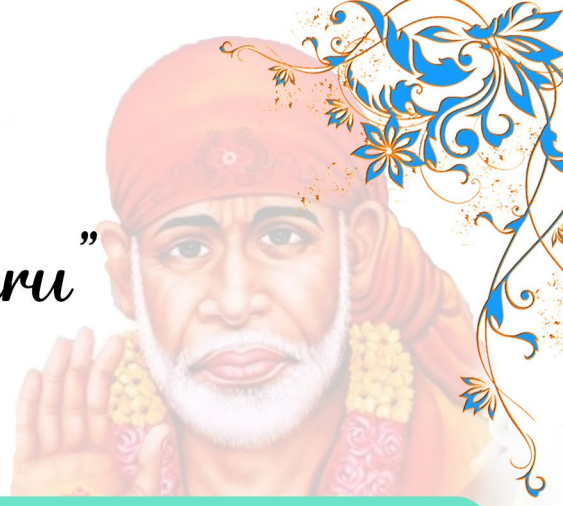
I was indebted to Baba in that moment, and will remain so throughout my life and even after. Am so fortunate that my wife and daughter are also Sai devotees. I only believe in Baba and his Leelas. There are many other similar experiences which I will deliberate on in subsequent volumes of the Sai Samarpan.

### *Saibaba is my "Guru"*

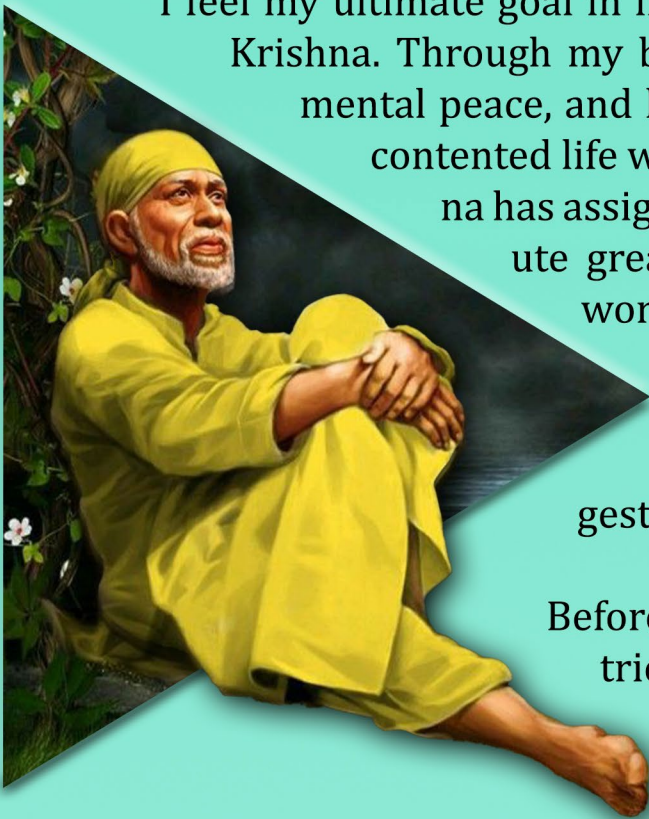

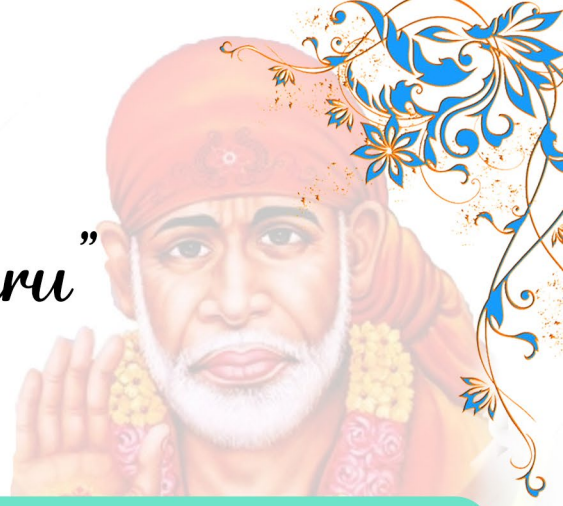

Before, in my teens, and in my 20s, I had tried to read "The Bhagavat Gita" so



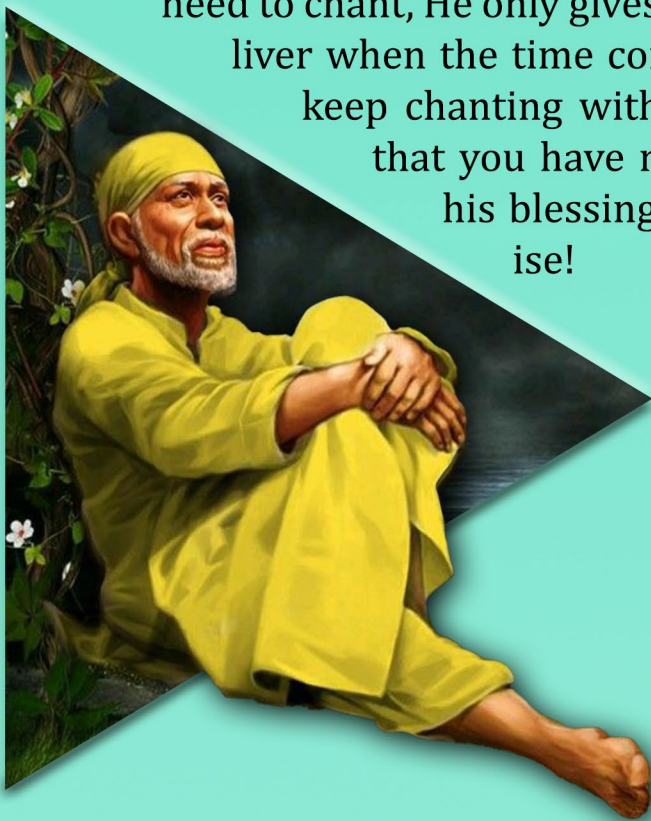

I reached the queue 3 hours early anticipating crowd and suddenly somehow I went to the PRO office, where I was made to sit in an AC room on the sofa.
