THE TRUE MARK OF EVERY PERSONALITY AND SOCIETY – MORALITY

The most essential requisite in any society is *Maanavathvam* (humanness); whatever be one's scholarship or scientific knowledge or position, one has to develop human qualities. To the extent these qualities are developed, to that extent the society, the state and the nation will progress. Where human qualities are absent the society ceases to be civilized. And the nation itself forfeits her place of honour.

Spirituality – the Basis for Morality and Integrity

It is only morality and integrity which entitle human beings to be respected. Students have to cherish human qualities. Only by adhering to the spiritual path can human qualities be promoted. They will not flourish in other conditions. A seed will sprout and grow into a plant only if you sow it in proper soil and water it. It will not grow in a tin can; it will only rot.

Morality can be upheld only through control of the senses. Only the person who has self-control is competent to exercise authority over others. How can one who is too weak to control himself be able to control others? There must be unity in word and deed. Only then can one achieve great things.

The Essence of Education – Sacrifice

It is undoubtedly necessary to seek a job for one's livelihood. But one should not regard finding a job and earning money as the be-all and end-all of life. Even in a job, one should try to uphold morality and integrity, and set an example to others. Looking at the world today, it would seem that education is for the purpose of practicing fraud on the people, making money through bribes and other immoral and unrighteous ways without regard for truth. Certainly this is not the purpose of education. Its aim is the acquisition of knowledge. The true values of education have been lost owing to excessive concern for making money. There is nothing wrong with money or education. Everything depends on how it is acquired or utilized.

Students! You have to exhale as much as you breathe in. This is inescapable. If you do not exhale, the lungs will burst. Likewise, while you have to acquire education and earn wealth, you must utilize both in a righteous way. The education you have received must be given back to society for promoting public well-being. Equally what is earned should be given back to society. Unless this is done, your education and wealth are utterly worthless. What has been received from the community should be given back to the community. That is true seva (service).

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This kind of sacrificing spirit is rare among students. They are interested in acquiring more and more. Life is reduced to a one-way traffic. This is not proper. What is earned should be utilized properly and shared with others. This is the way to ennoble life.

In swimming, you have to push the water back so that you may move forward. Likewise, renouncing material things is the way to spiritual progress. But, what you have to renounce is not wealth alone; you have to get rid of all your bad qualities. That alone is true sacrifice. Giving up hearth and home is not a big sacrifice. It is the giving up of all vices that is true renunciation. That alone can result in the blossoming of the human personality.

The Ideal Priorities in Life

People should realise that they are born in society, grow in society and live in society. Today most people are content to think only about themselves and their families and are indifferent to their obligations to society. As a result, they lose peace and happiness. Even devotees are more concerned about their personal interests and give secondary place to God. Consequently they are unable to experience real bliss. They lead purposeless and meaningless lives.

The Kauravas are an example of persons who sought worldly gains and power, forgetting God. Although they had immense wealth, what happened to them in the end? They had many valiant heros and preceptors fighting on their side. But all their material resources, their intellectual abilities and their armed might were of no avail.

The Pandavas relied on the strength of the Divine and the power of righteousness. The Bhagavad Gita has clearly explained that the Divine helps those who adhere to *Dharma*. The Pandavas relied on God for everything. Hence they were crowned with success. No doubt the Pandavas had to encounter many difficulties. But these did not overwhelm them.

The Pandavas placed God first, the world next and the "I" last. Hence they were successful. The Kauravas placed "I" (the ego) first, the world next and God last. Hence, they lost everything! *Students!* Give a back seat to the ego. Our history is full of instances of persons who set an example in sacrificing the ego.

A Russian devotee, Alexander, had been to see SathyaSai Baba and when he returned he excitedly told all his friends about the phenomenal occurrences that were going on in Puttaparthi, India. He told them an Avatar was on the Earth and discussed many of the details of his visit with them. But all listened mildly and had no interest in finding out anything further about this.

He started to plan a return trip and wanted to take at least one other person with him. He had previously given several books in Russian to his friend "Mikhail", but Mikhail would not read them. Although the two had been friends since they were students and Mikhail knew his friend was credible, still he had no interest in Sai Baba. Alexander could not understand this as Mikhail was a well-educated man, a professor and well known scientist with many achievements to his name.

Alexander had resigned himself to going alone back to India, but unexpectedly, Mikhail had called and told him he had decided to go. He had told his wife that he might stop drinking if he went and so he got her support. He thought he might pay for the trip by the savings from refraining from alcohol for six months. Alexander explained to him that no one was allowed to have meat or alcohol or tobacco in PrasanthiNilayam and Mikhail agreed to these conditions. But, even though he had decided to go, Mikhail still refused to read any of the books about Sai Baba.

They arrived at the Ashram and were given a room to share with other international visitors. On the third day Alexander gave his friend three issues of the quarterly magazine, "Divine Love" and Mikhail started reading only those articles where Swami himself speaks. He was transfixed by what he read and continued reading into the night.

The next day, Alexander got up to attend darshan as usual but did not see his friend Mikhail so he saved a place for him in the darshan lines even though the Seva Dal volunteer told him this was usually not allowed. Finally, a half hour before darshan time, Mikhail showed up and joined Alexander and they settled down to wait for a glimpse of Swami. At last he appeared and slowly, gracefully floated through the crowds until he approached to where the two Russian visitors were. As he went by them, Sai Baba looked directly at Alexander and Mikhail and made a sign with his hands three times. Alexander was thrilled as it is an unusual occurrence to receive some kind of sign or attention from Swami.

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After Darshan, Mikhail excitedly told his friend Alexander that last night he had had a dream in which Swami came to him and had a long conversation with him. Mikhail was confused because the dream had seemed completely real to him and he could see and remember everything just as when he was awake so he didn't know whether to take it as a dream or a real event that actually happened.



Then Mikhail narrated to his friend from memory, the following conversation from his "dream". In the dream he found himself in the very same lecture hall in Russia where he normally delivers lectures to his students. But instead, Swami was at the rostrum where Mikhail usually lectures and Mikhail was sitting at a table like one of the students.

Sai: "You wanted an interview - you will have it now. You always liked double lectures (two 45 minute periods without a break): you will now have such a period yourself. You may ask me any questions."

Mikhail: "Not everything is clear in religions. They divide"

Sai: "Religions were written for the time when people were primitive and so they were expounded in the language and concepts of that period. A blind belief and miracles were required. Look at Moses who was taking Jews from Egypt showing miracles. Each time requires

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its form. Temples were constructed but the real temple must be in one's soul. You did not want to read books about me, but you studied mathematics: first 2 X 2, then further, then physics. From the simple to the complex, but all the knowledge is held up by the highest knowledge which is God. Gradually one goes from intellect to spirituality; one needs intellect to live in the world. You started reading about me for the sake of your friend. Your friend is my channel. He brought you here and did it selflessly. Do not worry about material things - You have a good intellect. Just imagine that man's life in a cosmic scale lasts only one hundredth part of a second, so what difference does it make where you live: in a palace or in a hut?"

Mikhail: Where can I find strength?

Sai: "If you have spiritual strength, then physical strength is not important. Your program was to go swimming in the sea (this is exactly what Mikhail and Alexander had agreed upon). Go or you will be sorry. One must do everything sincerely, nothing should be done out of compulsion. You have a good intellect and it's not necessary for you to stay here long. You have to decide."

Mikhail: "How shall I live now? Maybe I should become a monk or work out an algorithm for my future actions?"

Sai: "If you put bread into the mouth of a hungry man then he will never learn to earn it himself. One can't work out algorithms for the whole of one's future. That is why you are given a choice in your life. I give you a trial and watch what choice you will take. on that depends whether you pass your test or not. If there was no choice, you would be slaves, and I don't need slaves. You should find a spiritual path by yourself, everything depends on you. You should not expect any gratitude for whatever you give."

Mikhail: "What concrete steps should I take to come to spirituality?"

Sai: "Let us take an example of water - it is a substance. One may pour it into a vessel; they may bring it to you in a restaurant in a crystal glass or you may pour it into a gold goblet. But the best of all is to go to the source, the spring, and drink it from there. The spring is in your heart. it is forgotten; you must yourself converse with God. What should you do? You must gradually change yourself morally for the better. You have bad habits. Start with getting rid of them. You have already become better; less proud. Pride is making you blind. Alcohol dries up your brain - that is the worst. It's an obstacle to God. Smoking dries up your body. It hinders your development."

Mikhail: "What then?"

Sai: "Act according to the criteria of Truth. One can clean the puss out of the wounds like Mother Teresa or help people, but if you are proud then everything is in vain. If you want you may bring people the knowledge about me, but do not be a lecturer. Nothing should be done without sincerity, one should not be lazy. Your wife is more spiritual than you, she is more

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compassionate. Both of you still have an opportunity to come to me - your life span is not finished yet."

Mikhail: "I can't understand: is it a dream or not? I am waiting with my group for an interview."

Sai: "The cleverer a man is, the less faith he has. There are no miracles in the world, only a level of knowledge. For you to believe tomorrow morning at Darshan I'll make this sign by moving my hand three times like that (and Swami showed how he would do it). That's the end of your double time."

And after the dream ended, Mikhail attended darshan where Swami confirmed the truth of the meeting by making the sign with his hand three times. He has repeatedly said that no one can see him in a dream without his willing it. He chose this extraordinary way to help Mikhail in his spiritual growth at just the right moment in his life. As always he showers his love on all.

3rd September 2011



We made this as a hectic day trip where we flew from Chennai to Pune early in the morning and were scheduled to return by the 10pm flight from Pune back to Chennai.

My niece joined us for this trip and while I worried that it was too hectic, I was also confident that Sai Baba would lead the way. We took the 4am flight from Chennai and reached Pune at 6.30am. We had pre-booked a taxi. We had requested for an English speaking driver but we got a Hindi speaking driver with whom my husband communicated with whatever little Hindi he knew.

We left for Shirdi from Pune by 7am and were there by 9.15am. We went to the Samadhi Temple and joined the queue. Since it was a Tuesday we were expecting the queue to be short but we were wrong. A friend of ours had said that if we let the security people know that we are NRIs we can have a shorter wait. But we were not able to communicate it with the people there and we joined the main queue itself.

It was a long queue. Generally my husband would get very intolerant of waiting and I had 2 teenagers who were hungry because we did not have a good breakfast. But that day surprisingly all were tolerant. At 11.30am (2 hours after we joined the queue) we still had no idea if we will have his darshan. Soon after something happened, the queue moved very fast and we were told to go into the temple and sit down. It was time for the Noon Arti and we had a fabulous darshan for about 45 minutes in front of Baba. He had again proven to us that we need Faith and Patience and he will take us in his arms. We were amazed as to how he had planned it for us. If we had indeed joined the NRI queue we would not have had such a fabulous darshan. Such was the kindness of Baba.

We still have a lot of problems. No solution seems to be in sight. Meanwhile I have lost my job as well. So now there is another dimension to the problems we are facing. But now I am much more reassured. I know that Sai Baba is looking over me. Every time I call for him he answers and says that he is there. Just 3 weeks ago my husband and I went to the Sai Temple in Mylapore, Chennai. On our way back my husband asked me about the fireplace in the Temple and its significance. I explained it to him. I could see a genuine interest starting in my husband's mind. That night we were scheduled to return back to Singapore. Normally when we go back to

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Singapore, we pick up Tamil magazines. So that afternoon, I went to the magazine shop to pick up various magazines. That evening we went to children's home which my husband helps out on a monthly basis and had arranged for a dinner for the children in the memory of his grandmother. It was a very touching experience for me that whenever I go to that home and see the faces of 30 children, I feel as if Baba is also there. I asked Baba as to why a good man like my husband has to go through the hardships he does? In the airport that evening while we were waiting for the plane we decided to browse the magazines that we picked up that afternoon. The first magazine I opened was Kumudam and in the first page I turned was an article with a big Sai picture explaining the significance of the Udi and the Dhuni fireplace in the Shirdi Temple. That was how once again Baba blew me away. I showed the article to my husband and told him that it was nothing short of miracle and Baba was assuring us that He is with us.

We met a guru who told us about our family deity (Kul Devi) and asked me to start doing Devi Puja on Fridays. So I started doing the Devi Puja. My aunt who does Sri Vidhya Puja advised me to take Bala Manthra from a guru and that would be very beneficial. In Singapore, we have a Shirdi Sai Baba Temple as an extension of a Devi temple (Vadapadrakaliamman temple). I generally go to this temple on Thursdays. So last Thursday I went to the temple and asked the priest whether he can start me on the Bala Manthra. He asked me to come back on Monday. Again on Monday I went to the temple and asked the priest. He paused for a while and he said that he is not qualified to do it but there was another priest in Sivadurga temple, and he will be able to help me. I had prostrated before Sai Baba in his temple both on Thursday and Monday so I was a little upset that I am still where I starte5d. So I left the temple thinking it was not meant to be. Then I decided I am not giving up and headed on to the Sivadurga temple the priest had mentioned. I had not been to this temple in years and when I entered the temple there was the Sivalingam and his consort Devi was on the right and she was none other than Sunderalvalli Amman whom my guru had said was our Kula Deivam. I then realized that the Bala Manthram was bait for me to my Kula Deivam Devi and make sure we make her happy. She was and has been there in my country all the while and we never knew it.

That evening Vijay TV channel showed Mahan serial about how Sai devotee Shama was directed to the Saptashrungi Devi temple in Vani village to fulfill his penance by Sai Baba. I could not help but compare what happened to me to what happened to Shama. And the timing was impeccable. One can call it coincidence. But too many of such coincidences are happening in my life and I will not insult my faith by calling them coincidences. It is Baba's miracles and it keeps flowing like a river. MY INTERACTION WITH SAI

I always upheld the belief that 'one makes his own destiny', and accordingly concentrated on my own effort without caring for blessings from any higher power. This power being invisible, I could never entrust my faith in it and remained rather confused about it. In fact I used to laugh at people going to religious places and keeping fasts.

Well, as years passed, obstacles faced by me became bigger and bigger, turning my life into an ongoing struggle. I remember it was 2006; one of my cousins came to my house and inspired me to read 'Sai Sat Charitra'. This was an alien concept for me but I had reached to a point where I was ready to do anything. To my parent's disbelief, I read the whole book in the prescribed time. I did not know then, this was the start of my spiritual journey which will make me realize that God has his own way of calling people.

Same year I had to go to Mumbai for some interview. I stayed at a PG accommodation where I got quite friendly with the caretaker. In one of our daily chats he told me about his friend's recent visit to Shirdi and I was surprised to hear that Shirdi was quite near to Mumbai. The moment I heard that Shirdi is only an overnight journey, I made up my mind to go there. When my mother heard she could not believe as I had never expressed any desire to go to any religious place. But being a religious woman herself, she gave me the permission.

t must have been 2 in the afternoon that I left the hotel at Shirdi to go for Sai darshan. After coming out while I was searching for the way back to hotel, I heard chanting of some shlokas, I realized, it was coming from the Chavri side. I was quiet tired, however I chose to move towards chavri. I heard the chanting for good 30 minutes in complete awe. During this arti lot many fakirs had gathered around chavri. I gave some money to the one standing nearby but the one who caught my attention was standing at a distance. He was a dark person and like any other fakir was asking money from passing people but still there was something 'different' about him. He was quiet a robust personality. It almost looked that he was doing a favor by taking money from people. His mannerisms amused me and I too felt like offering him some money. But since he was little far off I dropped the idea and started walking towards the hotel. After full one hour when I was just a meter away from the hotel, walking on the roadside path, I realized that same dark fakir was standing at a distance on the right side of the footpath. The amazing thing was that he was standing in such a way that I could not have avoided him. I saw his outstretched hands for 'dakshina'. His dark demure look almost frightened me and I started taking my steps slowly. I had taken out a ten rupee note to give him and as I dropped the note

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in his hand he spoke something. To my surprise, it was in English! I was too frightened to hear clearly but whatever he said it was English. Tell me how a fakir would know English? I have no doubt in telling that he was Sai Baba. He spoke in English because if he had spoken in Hindi I would have thought him to be like any other fakir. This was my first interaction with Baba. You would be surprised to know that same year on the Ramnaumi day I was standing in front of Sai murti in a temple at Delhi with eyes closed and suddenly I felt that same dark fakir was standing next to me. This was another effort of Baba to make my belief strong in him.

In 2008 I again visited Shirdi with one of my uncles. While I was waiting for the arti at Dwarika mai, one man came on crutches and suddenly told me 'tu mujhe aaj sweater kharidayegi'. He said this with such impersonality as if he knew me from before. I was taken aback but still could not say 'no' and told him that when I come out of the arti I will buy him the sweater. When I came out, I did not see him and with much searching I saw him quietly standing in a corner. He again was not like normal beggars. He was fair, short and a proud man. When he pointed towards a far off shop I asked 'haw far is the shop', he promptly said in hindi 'kyo ghabra rahi hai, yahi per hai'. While walking I kept thinking 'is he Sai'? Well finally after crossing the road, I bought him the sweater. While coming back he started moving to the other side of the road but I told him to cross the road with me as I wanted to test, if he is Sai or not. I asked him, 'does Sai give darshan to their bhakts in Shirdi'? He said 'Surely'. And then he also told that one should try to gather flowers which are spread over the Sai Paliki and one must try to go under the palki as it is auspicious to do so. I recently went under a palki but not at Shirdi, somewhere else. Now tell me, will any normal fakir talk like this?

Another incident happened when I was visiting Shirdi with my mother in 2010.I had read in Sai Sat Chritra that Baba gave darshan at Shirdi to someone in the form of his own Isht. Inspired from this incident, I kept telling Sai in my mind that kindly come in the form of a sadhu. Well in that trip we entered the main temple after a long wait and by the time we came out my mother was feeling very thirsty. While I was looking for water at Sai Sansthan, I saw a well-dressed sadhu calling me; I got scared as I did not understand why he was calling me? I kept walking. I had totally forgotten about my request to Sai to come in a sadhu's form. Maybe because, I never believed that he will come. While I was walking back also this Sadhu kept calling me but I did not go and went straight to my mother, Sadhu went on his way. Well the moment I sat down next to my mother, the memory of my request to Sai came flashing to my mind and I immediately ran out to find that sadhu. My mother kept calling me but I could not wait to answer her. I looked for him everywhere but I did not find him. With a heavy heart I came back and told everything to mom. She was surprised and we were little sad too but rejoiced in the knowledge that Sai finally answered our prayer, though we did not recognize him.

After this incident my belief in Sai Baba grew many folds. I believe he has his own ways of making people his bhakt. I consider him as a guide and a friend with whom one can talk whenever one feels like. I strongly believe now that strength lies in the belief that prayers will be answered and not in doubting the higher power.

I used to think why Baba does not give darshan in my dream? This prayer of mine also got answered and Baba gave darshan twice in my dream. Once I dreamed that some evil spirit was approaching me and I called out loudly "SAI BABA" and that evil spirit changed its direction immediately. Another time I saw some bad people approaching me and I heard my father telling me to utter Baba's name, as soon I uttered his name I was saved. I think

through this two dreams Baba wanted to tell me that he has saved me earlier from some unfortunate events which I am not aware of.

I conceived again in December 2010. The doctor initially had found some complications and told me if these complications remain even after 7/8 days then he would advise to terminate this pregnancy. I was totally shattered. Stopped going to office for a week and prayed to Baba. In the meanwhile I had another dream in which I was applying sindoor on Baba's left foot. When I was going to apply sindoor in Baba's right foot which is folded over his left leg, the priest of the temple started abusing me. Then I saw I was standing in a queue waiting to receive Baba's prasad and the dream ended. I started thinking, have I done anything wrong? Was Baba

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unhappy with me? Can't my pregnancy be continued? Then I prayed to Baba to show me some sign that my Baby will be alright. Now, I have bought a book from Shirdi containing Sai bhajans written in Bengali script. But I have not read that before. So one day I casually pulled out the book and was turning pages then I saw Baba's picture - the picture was of Baba's right foot resting on left limb and most amazingly I saw under Baba's right foot three horizontal lines like the ones we draw on Lord Shiva's forehead. At once I was sure that my baby will be alright and thus Baba answered that I have done no wrong (as I thought indicated by the dream). After one week I visited the doctor and he told me everything is alright.

Meantime my son was going to play school. Initially he was alright but after a month started crying and refused to go to school. We had to drag him to school and this continued. One day before taking him to school I bowed before Sai Baba's photo and told him that it is his duty to see that my child should not cry. And that day after coming from office I heard that he had not cried and from then onwards he is being going to school happily. From Samarpan I learned about certain sites where devotees raise questions and Baba answers them. Through that site I asked Baba the baby who is coming will be alright as I was worried still then. He told me to feed poor people.

I am not much of a cook and thus was thinking when to cook and whom to feed. Then in the month of April in our house we have Basanti Puja (puja of goddesses Durga) and on the ninth day it is the Ram Navami day, every year my mother —in-law makes prasad for Baba, but this year I cooked the khichdi as Bhog to Baba and went to office. After I returned I found a girl who used to look after my sister-in-laws son and two of our house maids, they were served the Bhog and I knew that my baby will be alright.

I have given birth to a beautiful girl child on 21st August 2011. I am happy that Baba has always blessed me. I think that I have previous connection with Baba in my past birth. I love him so much. Every painful prayer that comes out through my heart is answered by Baba and I think that this applies to all Sai devotees. I hope one day my soul will meet Baba. Let Baba shower his blessing to all people.

LOVE IS WHERE YOU ARE NOT

It would bomb as a pick up line, but it's a concept of love worth pondering. They are the words of Jiddu Krishnamurti, a renowned spiritual teacher who travelled the world in the twentieth century extolling the merits of self-inquiry. At first the statement comes across like one of those if-a-tree-falls-in-the-woods Zen mindbenders, but spend a few moments with it and it may dissolve into a valuable insight.

Tug on the word 'you' and the statement begins to unravel. You, as in ego. Krishnamurti was saying that love can only exist when the ego is not around to muck things up. Few of us would object to such a selfless concept of love. Similar observations by acknowledged subject matter experts like St. Paul and Kahlil Gibran lift our lips into hopeful smiles during wedding ceremonies. In those moments of stillness we contemplate the endlessness of human possibility, but only seconds later we are contemplating the endless flow of free beer at the reception. It's as if such grand visions of love are too hot to hold, or perhaps too unattainable to sustain our attention.

And anyway, who are St. Paul or Kahlil Gibran to lecture anyone about love? They weren't even married. For better or for worse, we view love as easily acquired treasure. This is because we define it as a feeling, rather than as the shared experience Krishnamurti hints at. We can't wait to report the news of our surging feelings to friends after a third date with our latest admirer. And three dates later we want to throw open the window and broadcast our feelings to the world. Something inside us has been switched on, and it's a marvelous feeling that's hard to describe. Eventually we all find the same word for it – love.

But is a feeling that any randy seventh grader can experience really what the world needs more of? If this is love, it is not of the selfless variety. It is all about us, and hooray for that. But feelings come and go, even the rapturous ones, making this kind of love as easy to fall out of as it is to fall into. Is this ephemeral quality evidence of love's sublime mystery? Or is love, the feeling, too flimsy a structure to stand on its own?

Divorced from feeling, love loses its conventional charm. When it's not being rented out for wedding ceremonies, the concept of love as a shared state of being is considered the property of ascetics like Gandhi and Mother Teresa. Far from romantic, it is a state in which the ego loses its grip and one's identity merges with those around them. It is love without a speck of self-gratification; in the absence of ego, there is no self seeking any reward. Love exists, according to Krishnamurti, because we no longer do.

As inspiring as this selfless model of love might be, who needs it? The old model works just fine. That is, until it breaks down, which it does most of the time when you consider the hefty

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divorce rate and then guess at the number of burned out marriages. Add to this the legions of lovers meeting similar fates outside the borders of marriage and we have what might be termed an epidemic if it were a contagious disease. And yet somehow none of this dissuades us from hopping aboard the same rickety jalopy for another perilous ride.

A more abiding state of love awaits those disillusioned by one too many hapless joyrides. We need not shave our heads or abandon all earthly pleasures to enter this transcendent state, but we must discard the notion that love is a self-fulfilling venture. Love and ego cannot coexist. Like light and shadow, they cancel each other out. For love to appear, you must disappear. You must give yourself so completely that no trace of you remains. Love arises in the space created by your absence. Love is where you are not.

Golden guidelines

Yearning leads to Transformation

Yearning is ignited when we are clear about the aim of our life. If one is not sure of what the aim of one's life is, then reading and study of spiritual scriptures can give direction to one's thoughts.

Every individual has Godly qualities at the time of birth. However, after being born, the child steadily gets acquainted with the outside world. The effect of the outside world and the way in which the child is brought up by his parents affects his spiritual progress. As the child grows, he gets more and more entangled in the Great illusion (Maya) and forgets his life's aim. Therefore, God takes the form of the Guru for the spiritual progress of each and every embodied soul (*jiva*). The Guru is the manifest form of God. He guides those souls who have intense desire for liberation.

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If a seeker has intense yearning, then he receives God's grace which helps to activate the dormant qualities in him and he begins getting transformed.

Learning Fuels Yearning

Learning helps us to crystallize in our minds what it is that we are really aspiring towards. Thus a desire develops to attain the goal. When intense desire for Liberation develops, then only will there be a constant flow of the Guru's grace upon you. For that to happen, we must try to learn at every stage and from every aspect of our lives. We know that God or Guru is in charge of all that happens in our lives so in the larger perspective nothing can go wrong with our lives. Lord Dattatreya had 24 Gurus in Nature. Thus we understand the limitation of our decision-making capacity. If someone makes a mistake we feel a strong reaction in the mind against the person who has made the mistake. This reaction may remain unexpressed or it may erupt into an angry exchange of words. Instead in such a situation we should contemplate on positive thoughts like 'Why has God created this incident? What does God want to teach me through the incident? What qualities do I need to imbibe to cope better in this situation?'

With regards to our own mistakes, we need to become alert and try to rectify our mistakes. Initially we try to improve our actions instead of going deeper to the source and reducing the root personality defect responsible for the mistake.

Pay gratitude instead of feeling distressed

During adverse times we should pay gratitude to God for getting spiritual practice done and instead of falling prey to any negative emotions, we should foster a learning attitude. BABA CAME TO MY HOUSE



UNBELIEVABLE EXPERIENCES WITH BABA

I am a retired army person re-employed in a private firm. I perform Sai puja in whatever little way I could, daily. Blessed with two lovely daughters and one son, I am a content filled individual praying for everybody's welfare. I am a small disciple of Sai and have been experiencing his blessings in one form or other since childhood. The most memorable to be mentioned are:-

My father was called upon for war duties in the year 1962. I was three years then. When I and my mother went to see him off at Railway station, I found my mother crying. When train left with my father, we came out and found a fakir outside the railway station who told me and my mother that my father would be coming in the same train with which he left. Go to Sai temple and place a garland to Sai Baba. This was the first introduction to Lord Sai and imagine in the year 1962, we placed garland on the statue of Sai for Rs 1.25 which my mother probably earned after doing contract job.

I had been praying whenever I get time, as a student. I had been relieved off my worries whatsoever came to me by lord Sai.

During Aug 1984, I had a dream wherein Baba came as a young officer in white half pant and white T Shirt and told me that I am first in my course which I was undergoing, it was Clerks training at Aurangabad then. I took it as an illusion and kept on doing daily work. Next day again he came in the same form and told me that you are not believing me. When I got up and remembered the dream, I again thought illusion and went to attend the class. There the senior instructor declared and I was astonished and then I realized that dream was of Baba only as daily I used to chant Sai arti.

While reading Sai Satcharitra on one of the mornings in 1988 when I was at a forward location in army, the photograph of lord Sai (Samadhi and deity Photo) in the Sai Satcharitra spoke to me about my marriage and I kept to myself thinking this as another illusion but in the evening a letter came from my parents and I was called. When I reached home, the marriage was fixed.

I was a witness in an Inquiry wherein it seemed that I am going to be convicted. In my dream a bold line square appeared inside which there were three faces (one being mine and two others who were culprits). I heard a sound asking me whether I want to come out and upon saying yes, my face came out from the square where there was no opening. Next day, I was pronounced acquitted and the two faces in the square were convicted.

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I had experienced ultimate blessings of lord Sai when on 17 Mar 1994; I was poisoned in food and made unconscious. After that kerosene was poured on me and house was lit on fire. All material belongings were burnt except three things viz Sai Photo, Sai Satcharitra and myself. The huge fire could not burn even a single hair of my body and I came out of the room which was burning. This happened when I came on leave. But believe me dear devotees, I met Baba at Rangiya Railway station in the form of a Sadhu who asked me if I can give him food. I gave him food and he gave me in return a red stone to be kept in my possession always to which I asked him what this is. The sadhu took that stone in his chimta (A Forcep like instrument carried by



sadhus), took out a long hair of his beard and rotated that hair to the stone and put that stone fixed on chimta into the fire of the dhaba. To my astonishment, the hair was not at all burnt. He told me you keep this stone with you and nobody can touch you. "Tumhara baal bhi baka nahi hoga". I remember that stone was in my pocket of the trousers when this incident happened.

There are many more experiences. I kept these incidents with me enjoying Baba's blessings. After watching the experiences shared by devotees, I have made my heart to come out with the above. Also, after the fire incident, I came to Shirdi and at Gurusthan, a 25-30 years old women

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clad in white sari and white cloth covering her head, came from behind me and said "Sai Ram bola ki". After this she vanished. I tried to search her but could not find her. This lady seemed to be an African woman. This was in 1994. Many of the devotees who visited during this period might have seen her because when I enquired, many told me, God knows from where she comes and where she goes but there are reports that she approaches many devotees, utters something in the ears and vanishes. In fact during this period I was a sort of psychic patient totally depressed with the situation without support from parents, in laws, friends etc but had firm faith on Lord Sai which has sailed me through that phase. Since then, my life has improved upon and we all (my family of two daughters, one son and my wife) are indebted to Lord Sai Baba. If any Sai bhakt wants to experience Sai's blessings, I want to humbly suggest that Sai Satcharitra should be read continuously regularly and leave the rest to the glorious feet of Lord Sai.

I remain a humble servant in the name of Lord Sai. May Lord Sai grant Peace and Prosperity to all. One of the experiences is of how Sai Baba made my younger brother walk from Bhandak (Distt Chandrapur) Maharashtra to Shirdi followed by few more experiences.

Blessed are we all that we still get glimpse of presence of Sai Baba. My younger brother who is retired from Army and now serves as Security Guard at SBI Ordinance Factory, Chandrapur Branch, saw a shadow in a Hanuman temple and felt that there is somebody present. What transpired between the shadow and my brother is not known but my brother states that he made a promise that he will visit Baba on foot. Accordingly on 26th Jan 2011, he along with five others started from Village Bhandak (PIN 442 902) for Shirdi. As per my brother's statement he was met by Sai Baba on route twice. All the same, a 45 years old person have traveled on foot for approx 720 KMs and had darshan on 18th February 2011.

As I serve at Pune, I intended to go and meet my brother and offer him a glass of water, but after all planning when I was about to start, my boss cancelled my leave on grounds of exigencies of services and I could not go. Baba correctly said that He will call His people with small string attached and nobody can visit unless desired by Baba. Walking up to Shirdi for approx. 700 KMs is itself a rare feat in our family and I bow to the power of Baba. Before this, when I was traveling in Maharashtra express sometime between 15 Jan 2011, the train stopped at Platform in Ahmednagar and it was about 0300 hours. I was the only one awake and there was nobody on Platform. I saw a big painting of Sai Baba hanging on which was written in Marathi "Welcome to all Sai Bhakt". First thing is, platform was empty, and secondly the coach stopped exactly in front of hanging painting made me understands that Baba is waiting for me.

Accordingly when I came back from leave, on first Saturday, I started for Shirdi and had a wonderful darshan. The garland for Samadhi Temple, which I bought, was sought by one person who was standing behind me as soon as I offered it. Again, one garland which I took was offered at Dwarakamai early in the morning, which was given to Sansthan persons and that garland was offered to Sai portrait kept behind the Baba stone. This made me feel satisfied that offerings are being accepted by Baba. Also, whilst again moving in Maharashtra Express from

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Pune, I noticed those paintings on Platform No 3 but the way my compartment stopped in front of painting on that day and only I being awake at 0300 hrs and watching Baba face to face (though in painting) is what makes it special.

Dearest all Sai Bhakt, please believe me, He is present in any form you think. After the darshan, I had gone to Ambikapur Sai Dham near Kopergaon. This Sai Dham is just 15 KMs from Shirdi and one Mr. Dhondu Chavan resides there. When I met him he said "You started your life as zero. You have risen from ash. Don't worry, Baba is with you always". I earnestly request all Sai Bhakta to visit Sai Dham at Ambikapur (Kopergaon). It is just 15 to 18 KMs and auto will charge about 150 rupees. This is a serene place and Sai leela can be experienced. Also, Mr Dhondu Chavanji if willing only tells about you otherwise he is always praying to Baba and is famous for being Baba's devotee.

I would also like to add here that during 1994, when I was still in Army, it was Vijaydashmi and since my visit from 1966 (when we were allowed to enter Lord Samadhi), I had a desire that I shall be a bearer (Carrying palanquin) to the Sai Palanquin, which is taking a round at Shirdi, but it was not fulfilled. During 1994, I was sleeping up to 1000 hrs and suddenly, I started for Shirdi after getting and freshening up. As soon as I reached Shirdi and got down from bus, I ran towards the palanquin which was already taking a round. Just then one of the person, who himself was bearer called me saying "I am awaiting you since long" please come and carry this around the village. Just imagine my excitement. I had done this and this is because of Baba's blessing. Dear Sai devotees, please note that Sai is alive and is helping us. Shibpur Sai temple, four Hours from Kolkatta is in the news now a days and many Sai Bhakt have started visiting. I have a desire to visit this temple also. Let's see when Sai Calls.




